

Sizing Guidelines

Sizing guidelines— The tag must disclose all of the information the shopper needs in order to make an informed decision. Specifically:

1. Choose the size for the tag that best describes how the item fits.
2. If the manufacturer sizing is different from the size you chose, then you must note that in the description field. This must be highlighted.

3. If you are selling a set where the top and bottom are two different sizes, you must note that in the description field of your tag. Sizes may not be more than 1 size apart. The differences must be highlighted.

4. Hang the item at the sale in the size you chose in the Size drop-down menu.
5. Please note that 24 month and 2T are different sizes as are 4 & 4T and 6 & 6X.
6. If a clothing item is labeled with a range (i.e. 3-6 month) you can tag it in EITHER size, depending on you think how it fits (i.e. 3 month OR 6 month) but in the description you need to make a note of it and highlight it. (see example)
