

What's New for Fall 2010

- ✓ We will have a **2nd drop-off in Plano** again. Sunday shoppers loved having more items to choose from! Registered consignors will receive details in the confirmation email when they register.

- ✓ **We are no longer accepting drop-side cribs.** The Consumer Product Safety Commission is working on banning them starting in 2011 and there is legislation pending to ban them as well. The safety of our shoppers' children is of the utmost importance to Divine Consign so we think it best to stop selling drop-side cribs now. Here's the link to the latest info from CPSC:

- ✓ **Handmade items reminder:** We do not allow advertising on these items (i.e. no website, email address, etc.). Any items found with advertising will be pulled from the sales floor.
- ✓ **Boutique section:** This season we're trying something new. There's going to be a special section for boutique clothing. These will be items that come from children's boutiques or high-end department stores like Nordstroms or Neimans.

There are some things to remember when tagging these items. First make sure for the category that you **choose "Boys Boutique" or "Girls Boutique"**. This will ensure that the item is put in the right section by our volunteers working the discard racks. You can even **highlight the category** on your tag so that it's easy for people to see. Also, if the item is a European brand, **choose the American equivalent for the size** and then explain the difference in the description (i.e. tag says size 7Y but fits like a 6)

Examples of boutique lines: Cach Cach, Biscotti, Janie and Jack, Oilily, Luli, Mulberribush, Me Too. For other examples, go to <http://www.achildscloset.com> or the Nordstroms or Neiman's websites.

These brands are NOT considered boutique: Gap, Gymboree, Ralph Lauren, Tommy Hilfiger, Dillards or Macy brands, etc.

- ✓ **Online waiver:** The consignor waiver will now be part of the registration process through My Consignment Manager. This will make drop-off even more efficient!
- ✓ Plano consignors **no longer receive an extra 5%** of their sales for volunteering due to increased costs at the Plano Centre.
- ✓ We have simplified our **Sizing Guidelines**. Examples and illustrations can be found on our Merchandise Prep page in the Tagging section.

- ✓ Consignors **cannot participate in both** the Plano and Grapevine sales in the same season. You can definitely volunteer at both, though.
